

## SCHOOL UNIFORM

The St. Simon uniform is symbolic of St. Simon Catholic School and should be worn with pride and dignity. **Students are required to wear the complete uniform every day, and a written excuse should accompany any deviation.**

### GIRLS' UNIFORM

St. Simon blue cardigan with emblem on left pocket *or* St. Simon blue pullover

White blouse with Peter Pan collar (Gr. K-4)  
(Long or short sleeved, to be worn with the jumper)

*or*

Plain white knit Polo shirt (Gr. 5-8)  
(long or short sleeved)

*or*

Plain white turtleneck shirt

St. Simon plaid jumper (Gr. K-4)

*or*

“School Apparel” brand navy twill slacks with a plain navy, brown, or black belt.

*or*

St. Simon plaid skirt or skort (Gr. 5-8)

“School Apparel” brand navy walking shorts with cuff may be worn during the first and fourth (last) report card periods

These shorts may not be rolled up, and they must be worn with a plain navy, brown, or black belt. These shorts are to be worn with the uniform blouse or polo shirt and never with the P.E. tee shirt. Shorts should not fall below the knee.

Plain white cuffed crew socks (no logos) which reach at least 3 inches above the ankle or plain white knee socks.

*or*

St. Simon blue or navy or white tights

### BOYS' UNIFORM

St. Simon blue cardigan with emblem on left pocket *or* St. Simon blue pullover

White dress shirt

*or*

Plain white knit polo shirt  
(long or short sleeved)

*or*

Plain white turtleneck shirt

“School Apparel” brand navy blue twill pants

Plain navy, brown, or black belt

“School Apparel” brand, navy walking shorts without cuff may be worn during the first and fourth (last) report card periods

These shorts may not be rolled up and they must be worn with a plain navy, brown, or black belt. These shorts are to be worn with the uniform shirt or polo shirt and never with the P.E. tee shirt. Shorts should not fall below the knee.

Plain white or navy crew socks (no logos) which reach at least 3 inches above the ankle

## PLAID DAYS/FULL DRESS UNIFORM DAYS

During the school year, there will be days designated as “Plaid Days/Full Dress Uniform Days” which will require that girls wear their plaid jumpers or skirts rather than slacks or shorts, and that boys wear slacks rather than shorts, and that Junior High students wear blue sweaters rather than the gray sweatshirt. Advance notice of these days will be given.

**\*\*PLEASE NOTE:** For quality and consistency in color and style, we ask that you purchase the regulation brand of slacks and shorts. Although less expensive brands can be found, we have observed that the color and quality do not match and after a few washings colors fade and the fabric does not hold up well. By purchasing the regulation brand, the uniforms will look better and you will be less likely to need to purchase replacement uniform items during the year.

## P.E. UNIFORM FOR BOYS AND GIRLS

Students in all grades are required to wear St. Simon sweats to school on their P.E. day. Wearing of this uniform includes the St. Simon tee shirt, St. Simon blue sweat shirt, and St. Simon blue sweat pants. During the first and last (fourth) report card periods, the P.E. fleece shorts may be worn to school in place of the sweats, or they may be worn *under* the sweats and the sweats may be removed in the classroom for the P.E. period. P.E. shorts may not be rolled up and they should fall above the knee. Sweats and tee shirts are to be purchased from Apple Tree Uniforms.

***NO STUDENT IS PERMITTED TO CHANGE CLOTHES IN THE RESTROOM FOR P.E. CLASS.***

**Junior High students** have the option of wearing a gray monogrammed uniform sweatshirt except on designated days. These days will be determined during the school year.

## SCHOOL SHOES

### **Acceptable Uniform Shoes:**

1. Saddle shoes
2. Dark brown, black or navy blue oxfords
3. Plain, lowtop, **SOLID** black, leather or leather-like shoes with tie or velcro closing.
4. Girls may wear brown or black leather or leather-like ankle-boot, laced with no heel
5. Shoes with a buckle, T-strap, zipper, platform, or elevated heel are not acceptable.
6. Slip-on shoes are not acceptable.
7. Soles are limited to a height of 3/4”, and heels are limited to a height of 1 and 1/2 inches

Please purchase shoes that fit well and that can be tightened with laces or velcro so that they do not come off. You can purchase school shoes at Apple Tree Uniform Store, Howard’s Shoes in Vallco Shopping Mall and Stanford Shopping Center, and at other stores in the area. For your convenience, we suggest that you call ahead to see if the store has the appropriate style and size in stock.

### **Acceptable P.E. Shoes:**

1. Plain, lowtop, solid black, leather or leather-like athletic shoes (same as uniform shoe)
2. Athletic shoes in other colors may be worn on P.E. days
3. P.E. shoes should have a non-marking sole.

4. P.E. shoes must be able to be tied or tightened so that they do not come off.
5. Only students in Grades 5-8 may wear high-top athletic shoes

#### DRESS CODE

- Faded, tattered, torn, or defaced uniforms are unacceptable.
- Shirts and blouses must be worn tucked in
- Length of the girls' skirts, jumpers, or skorts must be no shorter than two inches above the knee.
- Skirts and skorts may not be rolled.
- Slacks must fit properly and be neat in appearance. "Sagging" of pants or shorts is not allowed, and lowrise and bellbottom pants are not allowed.
- Shorts must not fall below the knee.
- Dress uniform and P.E. uniform pieces may not be mixed. For example, the P.E. sweatshirt may not be worn with the uniform jumper, skirt, skort, pants, or shorts.
- Shoelaces must be tied at all times.

Hair should be clean and neat in appearance. Altering of natural hair color, extreme or exaggerated hair styles are not permitted. Excessive use of hair styling products is not permitted. Boys' hair may not touch the top of the shirt collar.

Makeup and jewelry, other than a watch, ring, or religious medals, are not permitted. Only clear nail polish is permitted. Only girls may wear earrings, and these must be limited to one pair of small post style, one earring in each ear. No tattoos of any kind are permitted.

All students must wear uniform sweaters or sweatshirts rather than non-uniform garments in the classroom. Jackets may not be worn in the classroom. ***All articles of clothing are to be labeled with the student's name.***

All students must leave campus in their school uniform. Only participants in school-sponsored athletic events would be an exception to this rule.

***Failure to comply with the student dress code of the school is against school regulations and has the following consequences:***

- First Offense: A written warning in the Homework Journal.
- Second Offense: Student will serve a detention.
- Third Offense: The student's parent will be called and will be required to bring the needed article to school.

***Final determination of suitability of the uniform rests with the school principal.***
