## *Educating Children to Know, Love and Serve God and His World*

Dear St. Simon Parents, Guardians, and Students,

This is a reminder about two uniform/dress code items for the 2010-2011 school year. **First**, your child will need to have her/his hair returned to its natural color and style on the first day of school.

**Second**, when you are doing your back-to-school shopping, the School Handbook lists the following as acceptable uniform shoes:

1. Saddle shoes
2. Dark brown, black, or navy oxfords
3. Plain low top, **solid black** leather or leather-like shoes with tie or Velcro closing. Solid black means there should be no logos or designs, and black shoelaces should be used.
4. Girls may wear brown or black leather or leather-like ankle boots, laced with no heel.
5. Any shoe with a buckle or T-strap or zipper is not acceptable. Slip-on shoes are not acceptable.
6. Soles are limited to a height of 3/4 inch, and heels are limited to a height of 1 and 1/2 inches.

These shoes are available at Apple Tree Uniform Store, and Howard's Shoes in Vallco Shopping Mall and Stanford Shopping Center. Please make sure that your child's shoes comply with the above regulations.

Full dress uniform is required for school picture day on Wednesday, September 1 for Grades K-4 and on Thursday, September 2 for Gr. 5-8. This means that students may not wear shorts, and girls must wear plaid skirts or jumpers. All students must wear their blue uniform sweater. Junior high students may not wear their gray or blue sweatshirts. PE uniforms may not be worn on this day.
