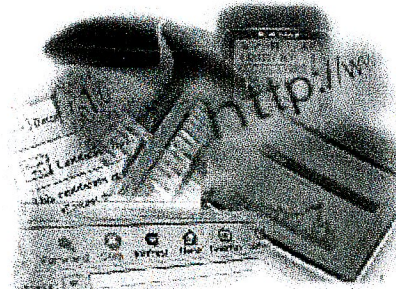


## Cyber-citizenship by Larry Magid
